



The Chapel of St Michael the Archangel

A stunning example of Gothic Revival-style architecture, built in 1890. Situated in the older and quieter part of the cemetery, it is one of the most impressive buildings in Rookwood Cemetery.



Mortuary 1 (M1)

Grave locations prefixed with M1, are located in the oldest part of the Catholic Cemetery near East Street, Railway Street and St Michael the Archangel Chapel.

Mortuary 2 (M2)

Grave locations prefixed with M2, are located in the area between Haslem Drive and Weeroona Road.



The Sacred Heart Chapel & Condolence Lounges

Fully restored in 2011, this 1928 built chapel is comforting in its traditional style, featuring a classic rose stained glass window, with wooden crucifix and Stations of the Cross.



Pope John Paul II & San Antonio Crypts

These recently built Crypts are an elegantly secluded area featuring a bronze statue of Pope John Paul II and St Anthony.



Mary, Mother of Mercy Crematorium, Chapel & Condolence Lounge

The Mary, Mother of Mercy, Australia's only Catholic crematorium, is a ideal example of modern religious architecture. The light filled contemporary chapel is subtly decorated with contemporary art.



Mausoleum of the Resurrection

The award winning design is awe inspiring, combining the best of the European & American tradition, it is uniquely Australian, features a chapel and reflective pool for contemplation.



Way of the Cross Memorial Gardens & Outdoor Chapel

Surrounded by gardens and a flowing waterway, this large elevated Pavilion with an altar provides one of the most unique places to create a modern spiritual service. The ceiling skylight is in the shape of the cross, allowing light to flow through the Pavilion.
