

Location Map

North Rocks Catholic Cemetery was established through the generosity of Edward Maher, who donated land from his estate for the cemetery in 1888 following the tragic death of his granddaughter. Over thirty members of the Maher family have been buried in the cemetery.

A section of the cemetery is devoted to the Catholic order of nuns from the Sisters of Mercy who founded their convent in Parramatta. The order established many schools and centres in the local area. There are over 200 Sisters of Mercy buried at the cemetery, as well as religious from other orders.

A notable interment was the Catholic priest and author Father Patrick Hartigan. His literary works includes 'Around the Boree Log and other verses' as well as historical research, poetry and prose about the daily lives of everyday citizens in the bush.

North Rocks Catholic Cemetery is managed by Catholic Cemeteries + Crematoria, an independent not for profit organisation who currently manage four cemeteries across metropolitan Sydney providing caring cemetery and support services.

Many of these cemeteries are sites of cultural and historical significance and Catholic Cemeteries + Crematoria are proud stewards of these special places, preserving the shared history of our community for the benefit of future generations.
